The Board of Trustees of the Town of Loma Linda met at 6:30 p.m. on Tuesday, July 9, 2019, 2019 in the Loma Linda Town Office. Trustees present: Bruce Anderson, Denny Holdgrafer, Gene Delano, and Tom Parr. Barbara Hutchison was absent.

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The First Order of Business was the presentation of the June 11, 2019 regular and closed meeting minutes: Denny Holdgrafer made a motion to accept the regular meeting minutes as presented and Tom Parr seconded. The motion was **unanimously approved.** Tom Parr made a motion to accept the closed meeting minutes as presented and Gene Delano seconded. The motion was **unanimously approved.**

II.

The Second Order of Business was the Financial Report: Jan Woody read the financial reports. A motion to approve the Financial Reports, as presented, was made by Denny Holdgrafer and seconded by Tom Parr. The motion was **unanimously approved**.

The Third Order of Business was the request for payment of routine monthly bills from the General, Utility and Park Fund Accounts: Payments totaling \$48,806.50 from the General Account, \$75.68 from the Utility Account and \$1,591.30 from the Park Account were presented. Gene Delano made a motion to pay the bills and Denny Holdgrafer seconded. The motion was **unanimously approved.** *Bruce Anderson abstained*.

The Fourth Order of Business is "Around Town":

1. Denny Holdgrafer continues to monitor the sewage flow, which includes Downstream Casino, and reports usage of 2.5M gallons with a decrease of 240K from last month. Denny will continue to closely monitor.

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The Fifth Order of Business was Old Business:

Old Business:

- 1. West gate status/update. (Denny Holdgrafer) Optic Communications has installed internet at the guard shack and the new arm gates are slated to be installed by the end of July.
- 2. Eastwind Road Repairs status/update. (Bob Goddard) *The initial repair work is done and the remaining road work is out for bid.*
- 3. Tree trimming status/update. (Bob Goddard) The tree trimming project is completed and within budget.
- 4. Park Equipment status/update. (Jan Woody) Additional Park benches have been added, new and improved baby swings were installed on the kids playset, new swing seats were added, as well as, a new porch/bench style swing added to the existing swing set. The overall project came in under budget. The Board expressed a "Thank You" to Jan and Scott Woody for all their time and work!
- 5. Town Hall HVAC status/update. The HVAC vendor recommends having the conference room on an independent system rather than have it split with the existing unit at a proposed cost of \$3,800. Denny Holdgrafer made a motion to approve the \$3,800 repair work and Gene Delano seconded. The motion was unanimously approved.
- 6. Insurance RFP status/update. (Jan Woody) Waiting on Kraft Insurance to update bid and once it is received, the Finance Committee will meet to discuss.

The Sixth Order of Business was New Business:

- 1. Town Clerk suggests power washing of Town Hall and pillar/column repair. *Town Clerk will research and get quotes*.
- 2. Renters at 2500-B N. Loma Linda Drive are leaving unattended toddlers that are either unclothed or in diapers, playing in the street on several occasions. (Rick Benson Properties) *Town Clerk notified Rick Benson Properties of reported instances*.
