## TOWN OF LOMA LINDA, MO MINUTES OF THE SEPTEMBER 13, 2022 MEETING OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES

The Board of Trustees of the Town of Loma Linda met at 6:30 p.m. on Tuesday, September 13, 2022 in the Loma Linda Town Hall. Trustees present: James Childers, Bruce Anderson, Gene Delano and Tom Parr. Barb Hutchison was absent.

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The First Order of Business was the presentation of the August 9, 2022 meeting minutes. Bruce Anderson made a motion to accept the open meeting minutes as presented and seconded by Gene DeLano. The motion was **unanimously approved.** 

II.

The Second Order of Business was the Financial Report. Jan Woody was absent. James Childers read the Financial Reports. Tom Parr made a motion to approve the Financial Report as presented and seconded by Bruce Anderson. The motion was **unanimously approved.** 

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The Third Order of Business was the request for payment of routine monthly bills from the General, Utility Fund, and Park Accounts: Payments totaling \$98,580.80 from the General Account, \$220.48 from the Utility Account and \$179.49 from the Park Account. Tom Parr made a motion to pay the bills and seconded by Gene Delano. The motion was unanimously approved.

The Fourth Order of Business was the Architecture Committee Report. The Board reviewed the Architecture Committee meeting minutes and discussed resident's request in New Business.

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The Fifth Order of Business was the Building Inspector's Report. Nothing reported.

VI.

The Sixth Order of Business was "Around Town"

1. August 2022 lift station reports state flows are within limits and in good shape.

VII.

The Seventh Order of Business was Old Business:

- 1. Street repairs Update. Recent Street and Road repair/work has been completed.
- 2. Park update Replacement flags were ordered, received and installed. Matt Barker has been contacted to give us a quote on landscaping the park.
- 3. Nuisances Ordinance update. James Childers. Closed meetings to begin every third Thursday of the month for ordinance reviewing/updating.
- 4. Traffic street signs update. Tom Parr presented pricing for new signs. James Childers suggested purchasing 10 new signs at \$72.00 per sign. Gene DeLano made a motion to approve purchase and seconded by Tom Parr. The motion was **unanimously approved**. James Childers suggested purchasing an additional 10 signs. Gene DeLano made a motion to approve and seconded by Bruce Anderson. The motion was **unanimously approved**.
- 5. In-Home Business ordinance to be reviewed by Board.
- 6. Residents on Foxfire inquired about additional street light at the back of the cul-de-sac. This was approved last month by the board.

7. Lift station on Butterfield (Cox residence) repair parts were ordered and expected third week of August. Update: Parts are on backorder and will not be here until mid-October.

The Eighth Order of Business was New Business:

- 1. Foxfire resident opposing street lighting addition. Bruce Anderson made a motion to amend the previously approved action from last month's Board of Trustee's meeting and seconded by Gene DeLano. The motion was **unanimously approved**.
- 2. Resident requesting Yield sign to be replaced at Willow Way and Willow Lane. Board discussed.
- 3. New Property Owner requests Westwind Road open/closed access. (see ACC minutes; project #1). Resident was not in attendance and will need more information for further discussion.
- 4. New potential property owners request for looking into revising/updating building code ordinances. Board will meet with Architecture Control Committee for further information discussion.
- 5. Building Inspectors requesting to raise building inspection fees from \$40.00 per inspection to \$50.00 per inspection due to inflation. Gene DeLano made a motion to approve and seconded by Bruce Anderson. The motion was **unanimously approved**.
- 6. Joh Adams resigning from ACC.
- 7. RaChelle Garman will work for Town Clerk on Monday, September 19, 2022.
- 8. Deer (Archery) opens September 15<sup>th</sup> through January 15<sup>th</sup> as per Bob Haggerty. Bruce Anderson made a motion to have Bob Haggerty oversee Deer Archery for Loma Linda. Gene DeLano seconded this motion. The motion was **unanimously approved.**
- 9. Resident inquiring about R1, R2 and R3 zoning areas in Loma Linda. Board will look into.
